InteCare, Inc. has developed a URAC accredited behavioral health care delivery system providing high quality, efficient, and cost-effective behavioral healthcare services dedicated to serving the mental health care and addiction needs for the people of Indiana. InteCare is a not-for-profit 501c Behavioral Health Network and Management Corporation that arranges for the provision of Behavioral Healthcare Services in the InteCare Behavioral Health Provider Network as well as provides Managed Behavioral Healthcare Administrative Services. InteCare originated in the greater Indianapolis area and has recently expanded throughout the state. InteCare is able to serve a broad range of consumers, including adults with serious mental illness and children with severe emotional disturbances. A wide variety of services are available for the treatment of emotional, behavioral and addiction problems in numerous locations in the state of Indiana.

InteCare has a defined application and credentialing process, which requires the submission of a formal application (with copies of required supporting documentation) with verification, review and approval by the Network and Credentialing Subcommittee of the following (as appropriate): State license and/or board certification; highest level of education; hospital staff privileges; DEA certification and CSR license; work history; liability claims history and sanctions; CMEs for physicians; and criminal history check. **Return the application and documentation within 120 days to InteCare.** The InteCare Provider Manual lists the requirements for participating in the InteCare Network. Please refer to the Provider Manual at www.intecare.org/Providers.asp. The subcommittee is composed of representatives of the organizations and professions in the network. The network receives and processes the applications continuously but reserves the right to add providers to its network as service needs and contracts require.

Presently, InteCare credentials behavioral health professionals with the following Indiana licenses:

- MD/DO specialized in Psychiatry, with Board Certification and/or eligibility

Organizational applications are accepted from agencies holding state certification and a national accreditation, e.g. JCAHO, HFAP, COA and CARF with a clear commitment to quality behavioral health services. All providers are required to demonstrate proof of liability insurance and a commitment to an established professional set of ethical standards.

InteCare is committed to providing quality service to both our public and private sector consumers. We are hopeful that you will participate as partners in our effort to establish a high quality behavioral health network that is responsive and fair to providers, and keeps the needs of the consumer as its principal focus.
